

Pre K Special Needs Endorsement (formally the EEH)

Endorsement coursework and field-based experiences are prescribed based on the program approved for KSU by the Ohio Department of Education (ODE). Previous coursework may be considered if appropriate and current. The courses prescribed on this page apply toward consideration by ODE for the Pre K Special Needs Endorsement and can be added to any SPED licensure or the ECE license. All Pre K Special Needs Endorsement courses also go toward the Early Childhood Intervention Specialist license offered at KSU. If you are interested in a master's degree from KSU, you must be fully admitted into the program and complete the prescribed coursework on the prospectus in addition to courses that are prescribed here for licensure.
