Notes

- 1 The minimum number of graduate hours required for a masters degree is **32** and include prescribed courses associated with research, foundations, and the appropriate option (thesis or non-thesis). Although hours required for licensure, endorsement, or certification may go toward a masters program, the masters degree must include the prescribed masters level courses as indicated on this page.
- 2 No more than 12 graduate hours (if approved by your advisor **and** meet the currency and grade requirements) may be **transferred** from another institution **or from a nondegree program even if at KSU**. Additionally, only 4 hours of graduate **workshop credit**, if approved by your advisor and meet the currency and grade requirements, may apply towards your masters degree and these hours would be counted in the maximum of 12 graduate hours outlined in the previous sentence.
- 3 Generally, **application for graduation** is required the first Friday of the semester you plan to graduate. It is your responsibility to submit the application to the Office of Graduate Student Services (418 White Hall) by the due date. No reminder is provided.
- 4 The Graduate Record Exam (GRE) is required for all those seeking a Master's degree in Special Education.
